Box firm boosted by accolade for growth

Logistics firm Bybox – whose countrywide network takes in much of the West Midlands – has notched up another technology success.

Following its recent success of being ranked number one in the Deloitte league table of the fastest growing technology companies in the UK, ByBox has now been ranked fifth in the EMEA programme. This recognises technology companies that have achieved the fastest rates of annual revenue in Europe, the Middle East and Africa over the past five years.

It is a tremendous accolade for the company which was formed only seven years ago to become a dominant force in night-time parts distribution in the UK with revenue

growing from £119,235 to £18.3 million.

Since it was formed ByBox has consistently used technology to provide competitive edge and in so doing has attracted an impressive customer base, including Siemens, Coca Cola, telnet, the RAC and Fujitsu.

Plans are also in place to further develop the business in the UK as well as setting up a replica network in France, which the company hopes to roll out throughout the Continent.

Stuart Miller, chief executive and founder of ByBox, said: "Being ranked number five in the whole of Europe, the Middle East and Africa is a tremendous coup for ByBox but is a position we could not have reached without

the commitment and dedication of our staff," he said.

"We are not, however, in any way complacent. We recognise that we are in a highly competitive marketplace.

"In order for us to continue to maintain our position as the UK's market leader in our field we need to continue to break down new boundaries. To not only further develop the range of services we offer existing customers but develop a new range of services for a broader marketplace."

Employing over 194 people across the UK, ByBox has 11 distribution centres, operates a network of 18,000 boxes at over 1,200 locations and makes 20 million deliveries a year.
