WANTAGE and COWLEY: Two Oxfordshire firms are in the top 30 of the *Sunday Times*

Microsoft Tech Track 100. Wantage based ByBox is 12th in this year's listing, which ranks Britain's fastest-growing private tech companies. During 2002-2004, ByBox, an overnight parts distribution company, saw sales grow from £1.9m to £12.9m. This year's turnover is predicted to be £21m. Chief executive Stuart Miller said: "It is a major achievement and further reinforces our position in the distribution marketplace." Meanwhile, Oxford healthcare information technology company CSW was ranked at 30. Based at Oxford Business Park, Cowley, its turnover grew from £1.6m in 2002/03 to £6.1m in 2004/05. Annual turnover has now hit £8m. Managing director John Chelsom said: "The key to continued success is to sustain this growth over a number of years."
