

Boxing with big-hitters

THROUGH-the-night parts delivery service ByBox has won a raft of contracts with blue chip companies.

The Coventry firm says a string of pharmaceutical sector firms have renewed their contracts, and it has new business from Siemens Energy, Fujitsu, Repairline, Carousel, Cable and Wireless and Leisure Link.

Contracts worth well over £1 million have been renewed with pharmaceutical manufacturers GlaxoSmithKline, Eli Lilly, MSD and APS AstraZeneca.

With partner UTL, ByBox has a three year deal with Fujitsu for its parts distribution in the UK, France, Ireland and Benelux countries worth several million pounds. The IT services provider uses ByBox to send parts out to its 500 strong network of service engineers.
