



BYBOX SECURES TOP TECH AWARD

A Coventry-based logistics business has won a top industry award for its revolutionary technology.

On Wednesday (July 6th) ByBox, the UK leader in field service solutions, won the Best Use of Technology category at the 25th Motor Transport Awards thanks to its market-leading Thinventory™ system.

The Award was presented by comedian Michael McIntyre at a glittering ceremony held at the Grosvenor House Hotel, London and attended by over 2000 guests. ByBox' Chief Technical Officer Dan Turner and Managing Director Mark Garritt collected the Award.

The judges at the awards – which is known as the transport industry's Oscars – were wowed by ByBox' innovative approach through Thinventory™, a software platform which they described as a “new way of working” and a “really good initiative which has generated significant savings for some major companies”.

They also singled out the “excellent traceability of customers' items” and praised it for being an “innovative solution to generate real, definable benefits to customers”.

The Central City Industrial Estate-based firm developed and own Thinventory™, which has heavily contributed to ByBox' rapid growth since it was founded in 2000.

Dan Turner, Chief Technical Officer and co-founder of ByBox, said: “Thinventory™ allows our customers to track their consignment at every point of the supply chain and allows us to reduce costs by eliminating the unnecessary steps involved in getting the stock where it needs to be.

“It demonstrates ByBox' inherent understanding of the needs of the market and our dedication to 'thinking outside the box'.

“We're delighted that we have been recognised by influential members of the transport industry in this way and look forward to next year's event.”

The company also recently scooped an International Safety Award from the British Safety Council for the health and safety performance achieved at its Coventry base and were listed for the first time in the Sunday Times International Track 100.

ByBox makes over 20 million deliveries a year into its unique national network of 18,000 dropboxes situated at more than 1,350 locations throughout the UK. The company has also recently expanded into the Republic of Ireland, France and the Benelux.
